18th Victorian Junior Masters

Day Two - Wednesday 4 January 2011

In stark contrast to day one, round two of The Victorian Junior Masters gave competitors what Melbourne is renowned for - four seasons in one day. Grey skies greeted the contestants with bouts of thunder and lightning followed by periods of torrential rain in the morning only to be treated with sunny skies and powerful wind gusts throughout the afternoon. Overnight leader, Tasmanian Samuel Rawlings maintains his lead into the final day by one stroke with a two round total 6 under par 138 from Jarryd Felton (WA) on 139 with one of the International contingent, French Polynesian Teramoana Beaucousin a further two shots back on 141.

The girls draw saw Kingswood's Bianca Ling's overnight six shot lead cut to two by United Kingdom's Daisy Macve who carded a second round 75 to Ling's 80. Julianne Soo is 4 shots back in third position. Ling sits at 6 over par 152 with Macve 154 and Soo 158.

The final day sees the top 60 male and 16 females plus ties compete in a 36 hole shootout starting at 7.30am with the final round set to start at 12.45pm.

What looked set for a possible run-away victory has turned into a dog fight with a tight contest for the honor of becoming the 18th Victorian Junior Masters Champion that includes exemptions to The Australian Master of the Amateurs next week at The Royal Melbourne Golf Club and the 2013 Victorian Open.
